

The boats “Scorpione dei Mari” and “Firefly”, based at Port Adriano, protagonists of the 2011 Palma Super-yacht.

From June 22 to 25, 2011, the most important super-yacht regatta of the Mediterranean was held in the Bay of Palma, with 21 boats whose lengths ranged between 24 and 62 metres competing.

The “Scorpione dei Mari”, a mega-yacht with a 29-metre sail designed by Tony Castro and champion the previous year, took second position in Class 1. “Firefly”, the ‘youngest’ 35 metre-long boat, designed by Andre Hoek and just constructed at the Dutch boat-yard Claasen



Jachtbouw, also obtained great results on its competition debut. Both boats are based at Port Adriano.
