

SKYE YACHTING TO SUPPLY PORT ADRIANO

Skye Yachting has just announced that they have been chosen to supply all the chains, ropes, shackles and thimbles for the new marina development at El Toro. Skye Yachting has been working closely with Bradney chains in the UK to find the best possible solution to supplying the expansion of Port Adriano. All the chain to be supplied is Lloyds certified and the shackles and thimbles are produced to British Standards. In the past Skye Yachting has supplied ropes for marinas such as Trapsa and are looking forward to being able to offer a complete supply service throughout the Balearics in the future.

Bradney chains have announced that Skye Yachting has been appointed to represent Bradney chains in the Balearics and in the rest of Spain. Bradney chains currently supply anchor chain to four of the largest yacht manufacturers in the UK including Sunseeker and Sealine. They also supply much of the mooring equipment to the RNLI in the UK.

Murdo Armstrong of Skye told us; "Until now it has proven quite challenging for many of the companies here in Mallorca to find a reliable source of quality anchor chain and anchors. Skye Yachting together with Bradney Chains now hope to address this and supply self coloured, galvanised and Stainless Steel, U2 and DIN 677 calibrated chain as well as anchors of all the well known designs. Every item supplied will be available with Lloyds Certificates."

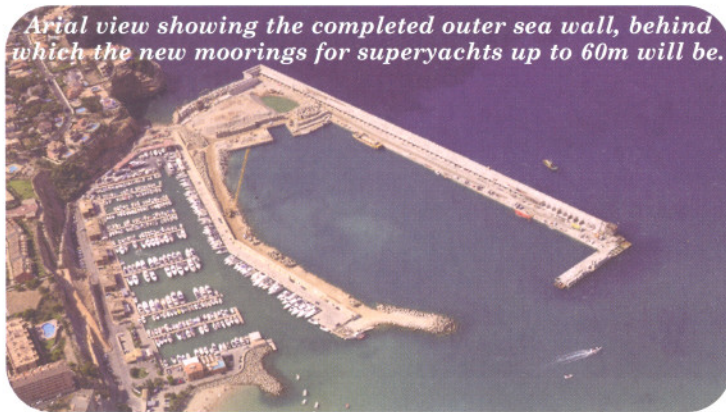


PORT ADRIANO EXTENSION - PICTORIAL REPORT

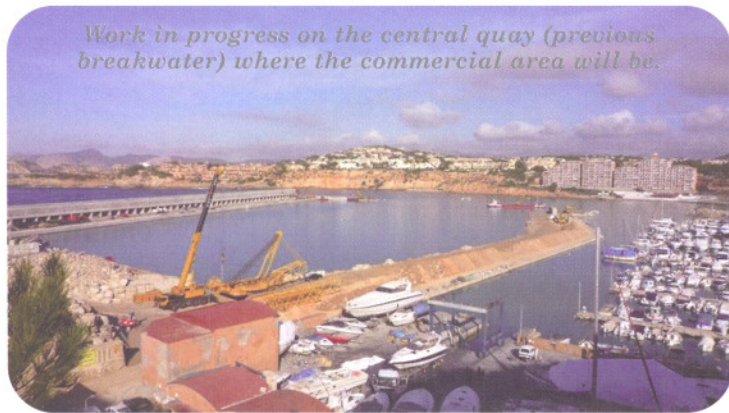
Visitors to the Port Adriano stand at the Monaco Yacht Show in September were able to see graphic illustrations of how the project is progressing, and how the enlarged and totally reformed marina will look when the port concessionaires Ocibar SL, and the commissioned designer Philippe Starck have finished the project.

With all of the huge concrete caissons for the outer breakwater now in place, the work should proceed with less disruption from the elements and is scheduled for full completion in March 2011.

At the time of the Monaco Show, close to 50% of the 82 new moorings for yachts of between 20 and 60 metres had been allocated. The port's future facilities include 670 new parking spaces, 10,000m² of technical space, a docking and launching ramp for small boats, 4,000m² of commercial space, and a 1,800m² area for customer service facilities.



Aerial view showing the completed outer sea wall, behind which the new moorings for superyachts up to 60m will be.



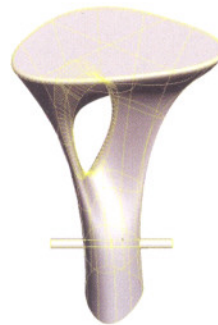
Work in progress on the central quay (previous breakwater) where the commercial area will be.
